Mikan! Odaminowin

Lesson Objective

Materials:

- Mikan! Odaminowin
 Document
- Mikan! Worksheet

Students will recognize vocabulary used in the scavenger hunt game in Anishinaabemowin and understand the commands "Mikan" and "Mikaw".

Lesson Outline

- 1. Print out worksheets and laminate.
- 2. Dress the children according to weather (rain or shine).
- 3. Help guide the children on finding the materials using the chart provided in the Mikan! Odaminowin document to the best of your ability.
- 4. Have children gather for circle time to talk about what they discovered.

Lesson Objective

Materials:

- Ininaatig igaye Manijooshag Story
- Maple Tree and the Bugs Story with Anishinaabemowin Keywords
- Ininaatig igaye Manijooshag Manipulatives
- Ziinzibaakwadaaboo Nagamowin

Students will recognize the characters of the Ininaatig igaye Manijooshag story in Anishinaabemowin.

Lesson Outline

- 1. Review the keywords from the Maple Tree and the Bugs Story with Anishinaabemowin Keywords document using the manipulatives.
- Read through the Maple Tree and the Bugs Story using the keywords and manipulatives throughout the story.
- 3. For a more advanced story-time, read through the *Ininaatig igaye Manijooshag Story* using the manipulatives.
- 4. Review lyrics for the Ziinzibaakwadaaboo Nagamowin.
- 5. Play the song once, then have students sing along for the second time.

Lesson Objective

Materials:

- Nanaboozhoo idash
 Nikag Mazina'igan
- Nanaboozhoo idash Nikag Numbered Story Sequencing Cards
- Nanaboozhoo idash
 Nikag Manipulatives
- Nanaboozhoo idash Nikag 5Ws Story Elements Colouring Pages

Students will recognize story elements from the Nanaboozhoo idash Nikag (Nanaboozhoo and the Geese) story.

Lesson Outline

- 1. Review the audio for the Nanaboozhoo idash Nikag story. Link is below.
- 2. Read through the story with the students using the manipulatives.
